All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the Borough of Harvey's Lake (formerly Lake Township), County of Luzerne, State of Pennsylvania, being all of Lot 25 and one-half of Lot 24 as designated on the plot of lots known as "Warden Place," the said plot being recorded in the Office of the Recorder of Deeds in and for Luzerne County in Map Book 1, page 54, said piece of land fronting on the northerly side of Lake Avenue, being bounded and described as follows, to wit:

Thence through the center of Lot No. 24, aforementioned North 23 degrees 30 minutes West two hundred six and fifteen one-hundredths (206.15) feet, more or less, to a corner in line of lands of the now late Andrew Hunlock and being the center rear line of Lot No. 24 aforesaid;

Thence be the same and along the rear line of Lot No. 24 and Lot No. 25 North 76 degrees 30 minutes East seventy six and sixteen one-hundredths (76.16) feet, more or less, to a corner of Lot No. 25, aforementioned;

Thence South 23 degrees 30 minutes East one hundred ninety three and seventy-one hundredths (193.71) feet to the northerly side of Lake Avenue.

Thence South 66 degrees 30 minutes West seventy (70) feet to a point, the place of beginning.
