BEGINNING at a corner of land now or late of Thomas McLaughlin;

THENCE North 33 degrees West 50 feet along Wood Street to a corner;

THENCE South 56 degrees West along lands now or late of the Pennsylvania Coal Co. to line of land formerly owned by Jeremiah Blanchard;

THENCE South (erroneously omitted in prior deeds) 58 degrees East about 57 feet to a corner of Lot No. 2 on Wood Street;
